Date- 7th January, 2026

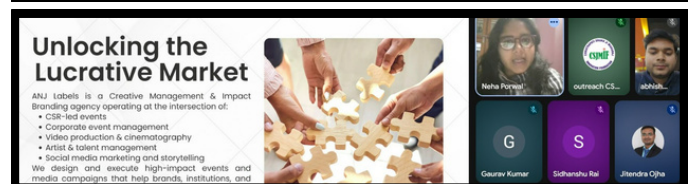
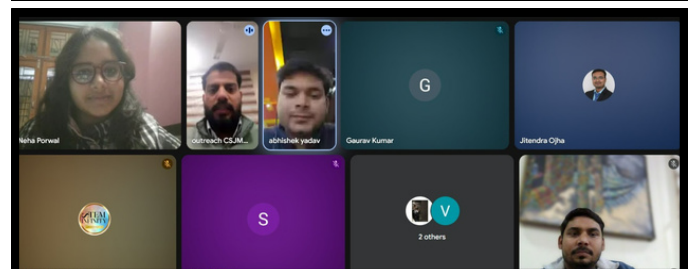
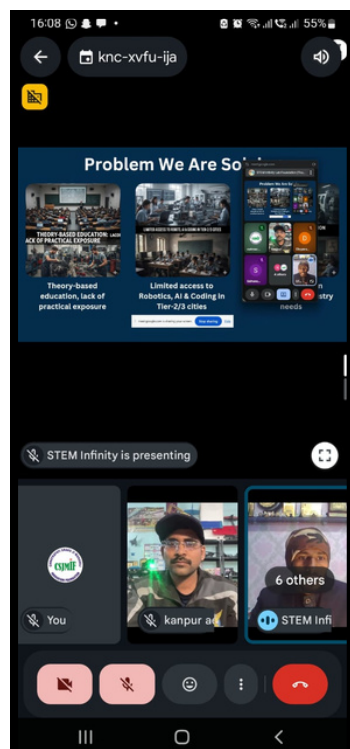
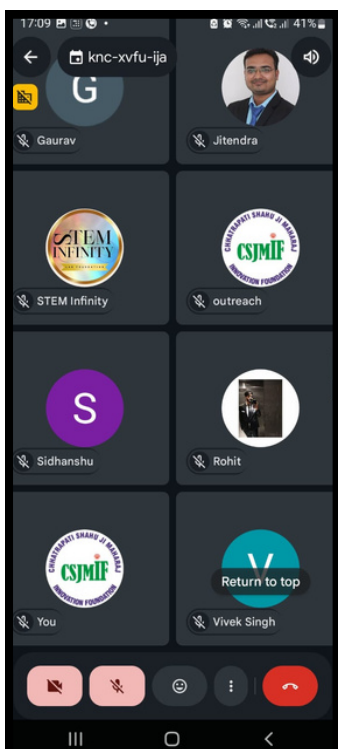
